

CALLING ON NVHC TO KNIT AND CROCHET

This fall and spring we are going to collect squares to donate to [Warm Up America](#). This is an organization that donates blankets to people in need. Their website has a list of the people and places with the current highest need. There are also patterns for hats and sock puppets, if you get tired of squares.

Sisterhood is going to collect your knitted and crocheted efforts to donate in December.

When: Anytime

Where: Wherever you can sit with your handiwork

How: Knit or crochet as many 7 x 9-inch squares as you want, and deliver to our collection station at the Hanukkah Boutique. If you cannot make it to the boutique, let me know and we can arrange another drop-off.

Pattern:

- Using medium weight/worsted weight acrylic yarn. Must be machine washable. Preferably machine dryable.
- Finished square must be 7 x 9 inches.

Crochet (Size G hook)

Chain 30 for the foundation chain

Row 1: Single crochet in 2nd chain from hook, and in every chain in the foundation row. Chain 1 and turn your work.

Row 2: Working under the 2 top loops of each stitch, single crochet across the row. Chain 1 and turn your work.

*Repeat Row 2 until your work measures 9 inches.

Knitting (Size 7 Needles)

Cast on 35 stitches

Knit every row until the piece measures 9 inches.

Bind off
